Trees planted at Audubon Nature Center

Over 100 volunteers from all over the country, including several from eastern New Orleans, chipped in to plant about 250 trees yesterday at the Audubon Louisiana Nature Center, behind Joe Brown Park.

I got my first glimpse inside the Nature Center since Katrina, and while I was saddened to see the loss of trees, I was also encouraged by the sight of hundreds of young saplings that will replace the trees that were lost.

According to Amy LeGaux of the Audubon Nature Institute, these specially-grown saplings will grow 30% faster than normally grown trees.

Louisiana Insurance Update

Louisiana State passed a [law](#) requiring all Louisiana insurance companies to give discounts to homeowners if their home has wind mitigation features. The discounts range from 2-6% for the type of roof and up to 10% for shutters and doors. Roofs that qualify for discounts have features such as closed cell insulation, hip roof, (not gable), and 8” nails (not 6” nails). You are required to have a Louisiana licensed “Wind Mitigation Survey Registered Member” inspect your home to know for which discounts your home is eligible. He will complete the state required form, which you will submit to your insurance company. There are six licensed inspectors in the state at this time. Go to <http://www.dps.louisiana.gov/lsucc> and click on “search building code officers and third party providers”, then type in a region of Louisiana and select Wind Mitigation Surveys. The provider information will display.

I located two in Jefferson, one on the North Shore and one in St. Charles. I think there is one in Thibodaux and Baton Rouge also. The cost of the inspection is around \$150 but may be more depending on how much research must be done on your home. If you provide the required information, there may not be additional costs.

Homeowners will receive information from their insurance company about the program when their homeowner’s insurance renewal comes due. 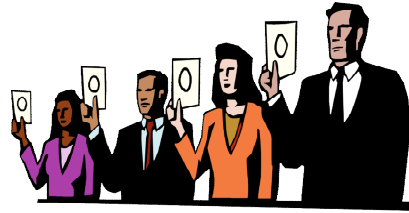
