There will be a hearing on Monday, March 8, 2010 at 10:00 am in Division J, before Judge James Williams, 234 Loyola Avenue, 3rd Floor. A Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) has been applied for on behalf of the owner of Southern Oaks Plantation prohibiting the owner of 7820 Hayne Blvd from continuing the construction of multi-family housing. The TRO also restrains the City of New Orleans from issuing any further permits or approvals for this construction project. The Restraining Order is effective for ten days. **As many neighbors as possible should plan to attend to demonstrate the importance of this matter to the community.**

The planned housing, located on Hayne Blvd, between Downman Rd and Paris Rd, would be a 3-story multi-family building, on 3 lots, one zoned commercial, the other two zoned residential. The project has been met with opposition from the surrounding neighbors.

Ladies Afternoon Tea

Jazz City Java Coffeehouse was the site of a Ladies Afternoon Tea on Sunday, February 28, 2010, with the theme "Go Red....Think Pink!". The traditional menu included scones, biscuits, cucumber sandwiches and other items, as well as an assortment of teas.

The guest speaker was Dr. Denise Rubion-Johnson, a Breast Cancer Specialist at LSU's University Hospital. Dr. Rubion-Johnson provided some sobering information about the state of breast cancer in the area. She stated that since Katrina, younger women are being diagnosed in New Orleans with advanced stage breast cancer, which is very aggressive. As a result a new CDC study will begin in October 2005 to monitor cancer rates.

Dr. Rubion-Johnson also encouraged the women in attendance to perform monthly breast exams and get annual mammograms after age 40. She noted that digital mammography is the preferred type because it can detect much smaller tumors, some as small as a pin head.

Finally, Dr. Rubion-Johnson provided information on where women can obtain mammograms, even if they don't have insurance. The St. Thomas Community Health Center, located at 1020 St. Andrew Street is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 12 noon, on Monday through Thursday from 1:00 pm until 4:00 pm; and on Saturdays from 8:00 am until 12 noon. No appointment is required, and walk-ins are welcomed.
