Last year, an eastern New Orleans resident, Minh Nguyen, received recognition for outstanding work in his community. This is part of the press release that was issued at that time:

New Orleans Residents Win 2009 Angel Award

New Orleans residents **Lynn Hobbs-Green** and **Minh Nguyen** have been named winners of the 2009 Angel Award®, presented by the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana Foundation.

The annual Angel Award recognizes eight individuals from around the state who do extraordinary volunteer work for Louisiana's at-risk children. The award includes a \$20,000 grant for each honoree's chosen charity.

- When her son's teammate was labeled incompetent, **Hobbs-Green** thought perhaps it was a vision problem. In helping him, the mental health social worker found her second calling. She founded The Eyes Have It, a non-profit organization that provides free eye screenings, examinations and eyeglasses for children at their schools.
- Feeling that his community was disconnected from mainstream New Orleans, **Nguyen** founded the Vietnamese American Young Leaders Association of New Orleans (VAYLA-NO). The organization is dedicated to empowering Vietnamese Americans and other underrepresented youth through services, cultural enrichment and social change.

“Making a difference in our communities requires time and money, and that's why the Blue Cross Foundation is pleased to recognize Lynn and Minh each with \$20,000 grants through the Angel Award,” said Christy Reeves, executive director of the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana Foundation. “Through the Angel Award program, we're partnering with outstanding volunteers to support Louisiana communities and create a healthier state.”

To date, more than 100 Angel Award honorees, from age 17 to 93, have come from all walks of life and have been selected based on their efforts to enhance a child's life – physically, mentally, emotionally or spiritually. What they have in common is an unselfish focus on improving the welfare of children in their communities. With the addition of these 2009 Angels, grants to their charitable organizations will total more than \$1 million.

A committee of past recipients of the Angel Award, now in its 15th year, considered 62 nominations from throughout the state before selecting this year's winners. Rounding out this year's eight winners are **Betsey Baldwin** of Gonzales, **Vicki Ellis** of Baton Rouge, **Jill Rigby Garner** of Baton Rouge, **Janet Leslie** of Maurepas, **Jean McManus** of Eunice and **Phillip Thomas** of Monroe. The winners will be honored at a presentation ceremony Nov. 5 at the LSU Lod Cook Alumni Center in Baton Rouge.
